Regulations:

1. All entries (which may have to be limited) must be in the hands of the Secretary, with fees in full, by TUESDAY 18th AUGUST.
2. Please use the proper Entry Form. No dog will be allowed to run twice in the same competition.
3. Handlers will be notified of their Running Order. Any Handler who fails to report to the Starter on the field in due order will be disqualified and the entry fee forfeited.

CLASS 1 – OPEN TO THE WORLD

1st £150 and the Frank Richardson Memorial Cup

Show jumping will be conducted 'Two Phase'

Two Phase jumping allows for the jump off to be run without interruption. The finish line for the 1st phase is the start line for the jump off (2nd phase). Competitors incurring a penalty in the 1st phase will be halted at the end of the 1st phase.

Class 15 Novice	Jumps will not exceed 50cm – for competitors who have never been placed 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd in any jumping competition.
Class 16 Open	Jumps will not exceed 60cm
Class 17 Open	Horse & Hound – Jumps will not exceed 60cm. Once round the jumps then Dismount and the rider runs around the course leading his/her dog.
Class 18 Open	Jumps will not exceed 70cm
Class 19 Open	Jumps will not exceed 80cm
Class 20 Open	Jumps will not exceed 90cm
Class 21 Open	Jumps will not exceed 100cm

Equine Section Rules & Guidelines:

An approved riding hat must be worn at all times when mounted (including fancy dress)

Age is as on day of the show

Equitation classes – judging is to be based on the effectiveness of the rider, and classes may include a suitable jump at the discretion of the judge.

Family horse or pony – to be ridden by two riders of different age, not to be judged on confirmation, but suitability and manners class may include a suitable jump at the discretion of the judge.

Riders aged 8yrs and under – Competent riders aged 8 or under may enter un-aided classes, but may NOT then enter the equivalent lead rein class.

Horse & Pony Owners are reminded that they are responsible for the actions of their animals and should hold appropriate insurance

The committee reserves the right to ask for any animal to be removed from the show field of considered to be dangerous to others
