Regulations:

1. All entries must be in the hands of the Secretary, with fees in full, by TUESDAY 26th AUGUST.
2. Please use the proper Entry Form. No dog will be allowed to run twice in the same competition.
3. Handlers will be notified of their Running Order. Any Handler who fails to report to the Starter on the field in due order will be disqualified and the entry fee forfeited.

Please note: The Society reserves the right to adjust the prize money or alter the trials depending on the situation on the day. The protocol and criteria regarding the challenge cups leaves these subject to the decision of the committee.
